PURPOSE AND PHILOSOPHY

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The school advisory board will decide on all applications for admission based on the following:

- 1. Applicant must be an officer or employee of a bank, bank holding company or savings bank; a staff member of the state banking department, FDIC, Federal Reserve Bank, OCC, OTS, or of the lowa Bankers Association or subsidiaries.
- 2. Enrollment is limited to the first 80 registrations received. Individuals who have never attended the Compliance School, or have not attended the past two years, will receive priority.
