What causes hearing loss?

Hearing loss can be temporary and caused by simple things like ear wax or a cold. It can also be permanent, caused by damage to the tiny hair-like cells in the inner ear as a result of exposure to noise, aging, other health conditions, or certain medications.



When should I get my hearing checked?

Hearing loss can come on so gradually that you may not even notice it's happening. In general, you should have your hearing screened every three to five years, and tested annually if you are over the age of 50 or experiencing any of the following:

- Consistent exposure to loud noises.
- Difficulty understanding in noisy environments or in groups.
- Hearing mumbling or feeling as though people are not speaking clearly.
- Ringing in your ears.

Getting your hearing checked is now easier than ever with in-person and at-home options:






What causes hearing loss?

- Excessive noise exposure is the leading cause of adult hearing loss in the United States.
- **Certain medications** including diurectics and some cardiac and cancer medications.
- Aging
- Certain illnesses and diseases like meningitis, heart disease, and diabetes.
- Other factors, such as obesity, birth defects, head injuries, family history and smoking.

How common is hearing loss?

Hearing loss affects people of all ages. The graphic below shows percentages of hearing loss by age.¹



How can I prevent hearing loss?

- Wear hearing protection
- Turn down the volume
- Maintain a healthy lifestyle
- Know your medications

When should I get my hearing checked?

Hearing loss can come on so gradually that you may not even notice it's happening, which is why it's important to have your hearing checked every three to five years. If you are over the age of 50, you should have your hearing tested annually or if you have experienced any of the following:

- Consistent exposure to loud noises.
- **Difficulty understanding** in noisy environments.
- Feeling as though people are not speaking clearly or mumbling
- Ringing in your ears.
